# Transportation Eligibility ...

Transportation will be provided to all students whose parents wish for them to have a ride if the location of their residence meets the following guidelines:

- (1) Students in grades 6-12, living more than 1.1 miles from the school which they attend, will be eligible for busing.
- (2) All kindergarten students are eligible for busing. Students in grades 1-5, living more than 0.1 (one-tenth) of a mile from the school which they attend, will be eligible for busing. Please note: Students being transported may be required to walk a short distance to the bus stop.
- (3) Most students attending non-public schools will ride the public pickup buses to the Middle School. At that point, students will transfer to the appropriate bus for transfer to their school.

# The first day of the 2018-2019 school year at Skaneateles Central Schools will be Wednesday, SEPTEMBER 5, 2018

#### All students will attend a regular full session.

#### For the first few days of school ...

- Grades 6-12, eligible for transportation, should be ready at the bus stop by 6:45 to 7:00 am.
- Kindergarten-grade 5 should be ready at the bus stop by 7:45 to 8:00 am.

After the first few days of school, it will be possible to estimate your schedule more accurately.

### Buses leave for home daily as follows ...

- Grades 6-12 buses leave the Middle School at 2:30 pm (Gr. 6-12 activity bus leaves at 3:10 pm).
- Kindergarten-grade 5 leaves Waterman at 3:30 pm.
- A.M. BOCES bus leaves the High School circle at 8:45 am and returns to the High School at 11:45 am.
- P.M. BOCES bus leaves the High School circle at 11:25 am and returns to the Middle School at 3:00 pm.

# 2017-2018 School Year Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) Notification Information

Dear Parents, Staff and Community Members:

The Skaneateles School District, in accordance with Section 763.93 of the Federal Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA), submitted Asbestos Management Plans to the New York State Education Department in 1989. Updated and reviewed annually, these plans contain reports of the accredited asbestos inspector and the reports of the accredited laboratory, which analyze the inspection samples that were taken. The Management Plans also describe:

- Places in each school building where asbestos was identified.
- Response actions taken to date including abatement of asbestos in boiler rooms, corridors, classroom, crawl spaces, and storage areas.

Copies of the Management Plan are available in each of the Principals' Offices and in the District Office. The Plans may be reviewed during regular business hours (8:00 am to 4:00 pm) daily Monday through Friday. # PESTICIDE NOTIFICATION

The Skaneateles School District practices Integrated Pest Management (IPM) in its control of all pests. We use DEC Certified Pesticide Applicators to apply any bait or other chemical pest control products (ant bait, bee and wasp sprays) that may be needed, and only after careful monitoring, exclusion and sanitation practices are first employed.

We control weeds through aggressive over-seeding, aeration and topdressing. The herbicides will be used sparingly and only on non-traffic areas such as mulched flower beds, fence line poison ivy and the perimeter of paved areas as needed.

In accordance with the NYS SED "Neighbor Notification" law, we will be contacting all students, parents and staff through our quarterly newsletters and other timely handouts to give you the opportunity to be notified directly at least 48 hours in advance of any regulated pesticide applications.
