

## **Capital Projects at Skaneateles Central**

As stewards of the district, we are charged with taking care of our facilities in proactive ways that advantage both our learners and our taxpayers. By thoughtfully planning building projects that address a number of issues at once and that also receive state aid, for example, we can complete the necessary work at lower prices while also receiving approximately \$.63 back on every dollar that we spend. By contrast, were we to do these repairs through our general fund budget, we would be paying the full price - possibly at a higher price because we would not be bundling larger groups of work together – as no aid would be received. For each of the projects listed below, we engage a number of the Board's community advisory committees as well as our professional service providers to guide us in our thinking and planning.
