We are grateful for this opportunity and want to gauge family interest in our community so we can coordinate our efforts with Onondaga County. Additional points of information.

- The Pfizer vaccine is the only one that is currently approved for students 16 and 17 years old.
- Students who are 18 and older can receive any of the vaccines available at public clinics or their doctor's office depending on supply. Students 18 and over will have access to the Pfizer vaccine at school.
- Registration and parent permission will be available at a later date once demand is determined in school districts throughout our region.
- The information gleaned in this survey will be collected by Onondaga County and then shared with individual school districts.
- As is the case with our weekly community testing opportunities, our ability to provide on-site vaccination clinics will be determined by interest and participation in our school community.
