STEM Camps

<i>In this week long camp, students will have the opportunity to observe, make, build, and experiment with different items. Materials will be separated into individual baggies for each camper to limit sharing and ensure safety; but it will not limit the fun, exciting explorations and discoveries! There will be about 3 STEM activities per day addressing topics like centrifugal force, chemical reactions, magnetism, and more.</i>

Students entering grades 1 – 3 in the fall	Waterman Primary School
<i>In this week long camp, students will be given the opportunity to explore, build, test, and reimagine simple machines. We will use ramps, pulleys, and other simple machines to create chain reactions and tinker with force and motion. As a culminating activity, students will use their knowledge of these simple machines, their ingenuity, and their imaginations to create Rube Goldberg Machines.</i>

We will begin the week using code.org and move to using Kodable, Bitsbox and more! The time will allow students to explore and play with a variety of coding sites and apps.</i>

<i>In this camp, students will engage in the Engineering Design Process to help Jacob and India. While traveling in Thailand, they learn that monsoon rains can cause severe flooding that cuts people off from important supplies. Students will help Jacob and India engineer “aid drop packages” that can be dropped from an aircraft, protect what’s inside, and are easy to find once they reach the ground.</i>
