Communication	Parent Square via email, select phone calls for those
	without email, letters, in-person meetings, etc.
Testing	For all unvaccinated individuals it is required to submit
	to weekly testing in an effort to mitigate the spread of
	the virus.
Facilities	No change.
Cleaning and Disinfecting	No change.
Public use of space	Currently the district is not allowing public use of our
	indoor facilities to help mitigate the spread of the virus.
	We will continue to monitor spread levels and open our
	buildings back up when possible.
Student and Staff Drop off and Pick up	No change.
Child Nutrition	Meals in cafeteria or in other areas if space is limited to
	adhere to social distancing guidelines.
Transportation	Masks must be worn on all transportation vehicles to
	allow the district to increase bus capacity and adhere
	to federal mandates. There is also no eating permitted
	on vehicles/buses.
School Schedules	The district is currently operating fully in-person 5 days
	a week for instruction.
Emergency drills	No change.

Health and Safety	We will continue to monitor and track positivity rates while balancing the maximum amount of in-person instruction with student health and safety. The district no longer requires temperature checks upon arrival to school.
Fiscal Stewardship	Continue to find savings within budget areas to allocate funds for ongoing and unfunded mandates.
