- ✓ 1 art smock and 1 old sock for dry erase boards

- √ 1 box anti-viral tissues
- √ 1 package of post-it notes (3x3 in. size)
- ✓ 1 pair of scissors
- ✓ For boys 1 box of quart size zip-lock bags
- ✓ For girls 1 box of gallon sized zip lock bags
