

Student Screening Procedures

Initial screening

- All students are required to complete a temperature check at home and complete a screening questionnaire daily. The screening questionnaire will be available on the school's website.
 - If a student registers a temperature above 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit or cannot answer yes to all of the questions the student is required to remain home and the student's school contacted for attendance purposes.

K-5

- Students that arrive at school are required to wear a mask until their temperature is checked **and** they are appropriately socially distanced (6' or more).
- Students will enter their respective building and report directly to their classroom. Their teacher or another staff member will check their temperature using a non-contact thermometer before allowing entrance into the classroom.
 - Any temperature in excess of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit will have a 3-5 minute wait time and temperature will be taken again, as per thermometer manufacturer's recommendations.
 - If a student registers a temperature above 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit a second time he/she will be directed to the nurse where his/her temperature will be taken again.
 - If the student's temperature remains above 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit the student will be isolated until the parent/guardian can pick him/her up.

6-12

- Students driving, walking or being dropped off will be allowed access to the building no earlier than 7:35 a.m. Students will be required to wear a mask and maintain, in so far as possible, appropriate social distance (6-feet or more).
- Upon entry into their respective building students will have their temperature taken by staff using a non-contact thermometer. Once the student's temperature is taken he/she will be directed to go to the library, cafeteria, or HS gym until 7:45 a.m. After 7:45 a.m. students are permitted to go to their first period class.
 - Any temperature in excess of 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit will have a 3-5 minute wait time and temperature will be taken again, as per thermometer manufacturer's recommendations.
 - If a student registers a temperature above 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit a second time he/she will be directed to the nurse where his/her temperature will be taken again.
 - If the student's temperature remains above 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit the student will be isolated until the parent/guardian can pick him/her up.
