

Suggested High School Supply List

The list below is generally what is needed. Students need a way to organize and carry paper that is passed out to them for each class. (4) 2" three ring binders and dividers is suggested. Your student may prefer a binder or a folder for each course. Perhaps they function better with a large binder(s) and dividers for multiple courses or a combination of binders and folders. There is flexibility for organizing oneself in the way that best suits each student.

(4) 2" three ring binders and tab dividers (dividers typically come in 3 or 4 sets of eight tabs)

3 to 5 Pocket Folders

Lined Loose-leaf Paper/Spiral notebook with lined perforated pages

Post-its

Small pack colored pencils

3x5 Index Cards

Ceramics

8-piece ceramics toolkit; modeling tool, ribbon tool, loop tool, potters rib, wire clay cutter, metal scraper, needle tool and sponge.

Sketchbook

Shoe box or plastic bin for storage

Chorus – see concert attire

Concert Attire = Concert Black

Tops; Solid black long-sleeve or $\frac{3}{4}$ sleeve dress shirt/blouse/dress. No spaghetti straps/sleeveless tops, no open backs and midsection must be covered.

Bottoms; Solid black dress pants, pantsuit, floor-length dress or skirt.

Footwear; black dress shoes. Preferably no sneakers.

Note: members of the Madrigal Choir and Women's Chamber Choir receive school purchased gowns/tuxedos, to be returned upon graduation.

Concert Band

Students are responsible for their own instrument care supplies. Student owned instruments should be in good playing condition. Recommended but not required; tuner and metronome (can be a phone app)
