<i>Get ready for the Summer Olympics by creating and competing in Summer STEM Olympic Challenges! Use magnets, paper plates, string, cardboard tubes, paper clips, aluminum foil, craft sticks, pencils, tape, and other materials to make surfers, kayakers, javelins, shot puts, basketball games, and more!! <i>Students will code using sites like Code.org and use Bitsbox to create their own apps that can be sent to and used on compatible devices. Interactive, programmable VEX robots and Dash and Dot robots will be used to make computer science come alive!</i>	
<i>Students will also have time each day to create and tinker with other STEM toys like Legos, Kinex, Marble Runs, Snap Circuits, and more.</i>

While traveling in Thailand, they learn that monsoon rains can cause severe flooding that cuts people off from important supplies. Students will help Jacob and India engineer “aid drop packages” that can be dropped from an aircraft, protect what’s inside, and are easy to find once they reach the ground.</i>
