The applicant must be a member of a Catholic church and meet all of the following criteria:

- Has been actively involved in their parish, school or community.
- Has been a positive role model to their peers, younger children and adults.
- Is a practicing Roman Catholic in a parish in the Diocese of Rochester and attends Mass
- Is a college-bound high school senior or continuing ed adult
- Will be enrolled in either a two- or four year accredited educational institution

Selection will be based upon the following requirements:

1. A well-organized, TYPED, size 12, double-spaced essay of approximately 100 words and no more than two pages in length describing why you would be a good candidate for this scholarship along with one of your future goals that means the most to you (attach to this application)
2. High school transcript
3. Community service
4. Two *confidential* recommendations (Recommendations can be completed using the attached sheet)
